## What You Need To Know...

- ✓ **FLASH DRIVES:** It's highly recommended that all Journalism students buy a flash drive (2 GB or larger) and use it to save their work. *Please be sure to name the flash drive; in the case that it gets lost, it's hard to return a "NO NAME" flash drive to the proper owner.*
- ✓ **LAB COMPUTERS:** The computers (in Rooms 433, 437 and 438) are not meant to be used for storage or to save files. Any files left on the lab desktops will be erased at the end of each week.
- ✓ **DOWNLOADS:** Do not download any music, applications, or large video files to the desktops. Students may download course-related files (sent as email attachments).
