TO APPLY:

1. Students should submit a cover letter and copies of three to five published samples of their sports journalism from **January 1, 2020 to March 19, 2021**. The samples should include copies of printed stories or links to broadcast or online work. The work may have been published in campus news media or professional publications.
2. The cover letter should explain why the applicant should receive the award. It must include a phone number and email address.
3. The entry must be received in the Journalism Department by the appointed deadline.
4. The winner will be notified by department faculty.
